EVENT INFORMATION SHEET

ELIGIBILITY

Scout	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Be registered as a Scout at the time of application and through till 4 October 2020.• By the opening day of Campwest 2020, have completed either the Scoutcraft badge OR the Introduction to the Scout Section badge.• Have completed four (4) nights in a tent as a member of the Scout section, at a Scout camp, with two (2) of those nights being consecutive. Camping with family or at school etc. does not count.• Have approval from their Troop/Unit Council and Scout Leader (or Leader-In-Charge).• Have consent from their parents/guardian.• Not have had their 15th birthday before the opening day of Campwest 2020 (26 September 2020).• <i>Recommended but not essential: have completed either the Pioneer Campcraft badge OR Stage 3 Camping.*</i>
Venturer	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Be registered as a Venturer Scout at the time of application and through till 4 October 2020.• By the opening day of Campwest 2020, have completed either the Venturer Skills Award OR the Introduction to Venturer Scouts badge.• Have a desire to provide service to Scouts.• Have approval from their Unit Council and Venturer Leader as being of excellent character, a good role model to Scouts and possess the skills and abilities to undertake the tasks allocated.• Have consent from their parents/guardian.• Be 15 years of age before the opening day of Campwest 2020 on 26 September 2020.
Rover	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Be registered as a Rover Scout at the time of application and through till 4 October 2020.• Be 18 years of age before the opening day of Campwest 2020 on 26 September 2020.• Have approval from their Unit Leader as being of excellent character, a good role model to Scouts and has the skills and abilities to undertake the tasks allocated.• Not have had their 26th birthday before the opening day of Campwest 2020 on 26 September 2020.
Leader	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Hold a Certificate of Adult Appointment at the time of application and through till 4 October 2020.• Be recommended by their Group Leader (or leader in charge).
Other Adult	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Must be a registered member of Scouts Australia (e.g. Office Holders, Fellowship) at the time of application and through till 4 October 2020.• Be recommended by their line manager.

*This recommended requirement gives an indication of the level of badgework that would best prepare a Scout for Campwest 2020, including skills in patrol camping, food preparation, organisation of personal gear and personal hygiene. This recommendation is at the discretion of Troop/Unit Councils and Scout Leaders.

HOW TO APPLY

Applications for Campwest 2020 must be completed using MyScout. All applicants must apply individually – there is no option to register members of your Unit in bulk for Campwest 2020. The registration site is: wa.myscout.com.au/events/191/registration.

Applications close at 11.59pm on Friday 26 June 2020. No further applications can be accepted after this time.

MEDICAL OBLIGATIONS & SPECIAL DIETS

Should the applicant's medical conditions change from the information provided on their initial application, prior to Campwest 2020, it is the obligation of the applicant (or parent/guardian) to advise the Event Management Team immediately of such change either through the MyScout online system or by written confirmation directly to campwest@scoutswa.com.au.

The following special diets will be catered for at Campwest 2020: vegetarian, egg free, nut free, gluten free and lactose free. Special diets need to be identified in your online application in MyScout. Due to the volume of participants attending Campwest 2020, we will not be able to cater for other diets, dietary choices or supply specific brand requests. WAIVER FORM

One activity requires participants to have a completed waiver form signed by their parent or guardian. Should a participant (or their parent/guardian) choose not to complete the activity, a substitute activity will be arranged. No refunds will be provided.

FEE INCLUSIONS

- Full Campwest 2020 program, including offsite and onsite activities. Some optional activities may be made available at an additional cost.
- All accommodation costs from Saturday 26 September to Saturday 3 October 2020, inclusive.
- Travel to and from offsite activities.
- Airport transfers to and from Perth Airport for those flying from regional areas of Western Australia.
- All meals for the duration of Campwest 2020.
- One (1) Campwest 2020 badge and one (1) Campwest 2020 t-shirt.

To ensure the correct size is ordered, please refer to the sizing chart available in the MyScout registration system. Remember to allow for changes in size between now and the event. Shirt sizes cannot be changed after registrations close and there will be no opportunity to swap shirt sizes whilst at the event.

VOLUNTEER ROLES

- At the time of application, Venturer Scouts, Rover Scouts, Leaders and other adults will have the opportunity to indicate their role preference for Campwest 2020.
- Once applications close, the Event Management Team will allocate volunteers to roles, with individual role preferences and the operational requirements of the event in mind.
