Thank you for your patience and work on the COVID-19 Safety plans. As you would've seen, the WA State Government Stage 3 restrictions were announced on Friday.

Though we're awaiting the formal legislation in regards to paperwork requirements of Stage 3, we are pleased to announce face to face scouting is allowed to fully recommence from 6th June 2020. Any changes from the media release that come with the formal directive will be told to members as soon as possible.

It's important that 2 square metres per person, maximum of 100 people inside and 1.5m physical distancing and ongoing increased hygiene measures are adhered to, and that people who are immunocompromised, at risk or unwell with any cough, fever or flu like symptoms do not attend.
