**Position Objective:** The Jambassadors form a team of youth members charged with promoting the Jamboree to all members of Scouts WA.

**Where do I fit in?** As a Jambassador, you will report directly to an Assistant Contingent Leader. They will be your mentor to help you grow into this role over the next 12 months. Your key task will be to promote the Jamboree by sharing your own experiences at events and roadshow presentations at Scout Groups. You may end up attending the Jamboree as a Scout, Venturer Scout or Rover Scout, depending on your circumstances.

**Specific duties:**

- Attend training to prepare you for Jamboree Roadshow presentations across Western Australia.
- Visit Scout Units around Western Australia to deliver Jamboree Roadshows where you'll promote the Jamboree and share your own experiences from AJ2016 or AJ2019.
- Engage with youth members and their parents at promotional events to grow our Contingent.
- Participant in other Jamboree promotions to get Western Australians exciting about AJ2022!
