Good evening everyone,

As you may have seen earlier tonight, the Premier announced a four-day lockdown for the Perth and Peel regions.

This means that all Scouting activities in the Perth and Peel regions planned for this week must cease for the next four days. If possible, Units should look at meeting online for the next week.

It is anticipated that the State Government will provide further update over the coming days and the COVID-19 Action Group will review the Directions and provide advice as necessary.

As with previous lockdowns there has been a gradual easing of restrictions and Groups should consider what camps and activities are planned for the coming weekend and the coming weeks. While it is not necessary to immediately cancel these activities and camps Groups should start to put plans into place should it be required.

For all members, I encourage you to keep up to date with the latest announcements from the State Government.

Members and Groups outside of the Perth and Peel regions may be able to continue with normal scouting activities over the week but should check the latest advice and restriction from health authorities.

We encourage all members in the Perth and Peel regions to follow the health authority direction including the wearing of masks. If you are feeling unwell or show any flu like symptoms signs we encourage you to get tested as soon as possible.
