Team Member Information

Scouts WA has a number of Teams which support the core Youth Program. These Teams provide a valuable opportunity for youth members to engage in a number of different events, activities and pursuits which enhance the young person's experience in Scouting.

These 'Teams' are generally led by a Branch Commissioner, Branch Leader or Team Leader and are complemented by 'Team Members'.

An appointment as a Team Member is a secondary appointment to the Youth or Adults Member's primary appointment. A Youth Member's primary appointment might be as a Scout, Venturer Scout or Rover Scout. An Adult Member's primary appointment might be as a Section or Group Leader, a Commissioner or a Fellowship Member.

The 'Team Leader' is empowered to appoint a Team Member to their team with approval from the relevant Branch Commissioner.

Appointments should be reviewed on a regular basis to ensure the Team Member is still active in the Team. All Event Committee Team appointments are for the duration of the event only.

The appointment of Team Member will be subject to the following criteria:

- The individual must demonstrate a mature nature
- The individual must commit to being an active member of the Team
- The individual must be willing to work towards any qualifications required to be a member of that Team
- Leader Training Team and Adventurous Activity Team members must be willing to obtain a Provide First Aid Certification (where age permits)

In consultation with the relevant Deputy Chief Commissioner, the Branch Commissioner and/or Leader in Charge will set any additional qualifications required of Team Members.

Adult Members seeking to be appointed as a Team Member must satisfy the Adult Membership requirements. On-demand training will include WHS for Scouting and Child Safe Scouting.

Youth members seeking appointment to a Team should complete a Y10 form.

Wearing of uniform

Should the need arise for Team Members to wear uniform, they would be entitled to wear the formal uniform if their primary appointment allows for the uniform to be worn.

If the primary appointment doesn't allow for a uniform to be worn, ie: a fellowship or committee member, then they will not be permitted to wear uniform.
